MEDIA ACCREDITATION

Sydney Film Festival accreditation is exclusively reserved for media professionals. Festival accreditation is required to gain access to Sydney Film Festival screenings, advance screenings, the media centre, redcarpet events and other associated events.

The accreditation application deadline is **5pm Friday 16 May 2014**. Any accreditation requests received after this date will be subject to restrictions.

Application forms can be downloaded online at sff.org.au/media and returned to Sydney Film Festival via email or post – contact details below. Accredited media will be contacted once their application has been lodged and will be processed in order of application.

MEDIA IMAGES

Film stills from titles screening in SFF 2014 are available via image.net. Media need to register with Image Net to access images and search for Sydney Film Festival 2014. Registration is free.

MEDIA SCREENERS

Some SFF 2014 titles will be available for media to preview in advance of the Festival on request. A limited number of press screenings will also be scheduled in advance and during the Festival. Please forward any requests for access to media screeners and screenings to Cardinal Spin (see end of release).

TICKETING PROCEDURES

Flexipasses, Opening and Closing Night tickets are now on sale.

Single-session tickets will be on sale from Wednesday 7 May, from 11am.

All tickets and passes can be bought and redeemed through the Festival website sff.org.au or over the phone on 1300 733 733.

Please Note:

- Media Tickets need to be requested via email before 4 June. Once approved, media can have their tickets sent directly via email, where they can either be printed or better yet, using the SFF 2014 app on iPhone and Android, be scanned at the door. It is also possible to collect media tickets from the Media Centre at The Festival Hub during opening hours (see above).
- Accredited media will be issued with single tickets only
- Media tickets are issued on a first-come basis
- Some limited sessions have a restricted media allocation and requests for tickets will need to be filed with the film distributor directly.
- Smaller venues have limited capacity and therefore have a limited number of media tickets
- Opening Night and Closing Night Galas are invitation-only events

Sydney Film Festival screens feature films, documentaries, short films and animated films across the city at the State Theatre, Event Cinemas George Street, Dendy Opera Quays, the Art Gallery of NSW, Hayden Orpheum Picture Palace Cremorne, the Apple Store, SFFTV at Martin Place, Skyline Drive-In Blacktown, and the Festival Hub at Town Hall.
