

2017 LEXUS AUSTRALIA SHORT FILM FELLOWSHIP ONE WEEK TO GO, ENTRIES CLOSE 01 DEC

Filmmakers have just one week to get their entries in to the largest cash fellowship (AUD\$200,000) for short film in Australia: the 2017 Lexus Australia Short Film Fellowship.

Brought to you by **Sydney Film Festival** and **Lexus Australia**, for the second year, filmmakers have until 1 December to submit. The Fellowship is a chance to be among four filmmakers awarded **\$50,000 each**! to produce their next short film to premiere at the **Sydney Film Festival in 2018**.

It's a simple process with no entry fee. All filmmakers are required to do is submit an eligible film and curriculum vitae by 1 December at *www.sff.org.au/fellowship*.

Australian screen icon **Judy Davis** who chaired the 2016 **Lexus Australia Short Film Fellowship Jury** said, "The Fellowship offers an incredible investment in nurturing the next generation of Australian film industry achievers. It was an honour to be involved in selecting the four winners of the Fellowship last year: Anya Beyersdorf, Brooke Goldfinch, Alex Murawski and Alex Ryan, who are in the process of creating four incredibly exciting films to premiere at the 2017 Sydney Film Festival."

Festival Director **Nashen Moodley** said, "The Festival is delighted to again work with Lexus Australia to offer this important Fellowship. The Fellowship is a significant investment in young and emerging Australian filmmakers, providing a level of funding not previously available to local filmmakers to tell their stories through short film."
