**DOCUMENTARY** The incredible true story of a TV contestant left naked in a room, unaware his months-long challenge was being broadcast to millions by a Japanese television show.

**DOCUMENTARY** The rip-roaring story, shamefully untold for decades, of the 1971 Women's Soccer World Cup, revealed by the awe-inspiring players who competed in the trailblazing tournament.



**Explanation For Everything**

**FEATURE** In this clever satire about the culture wars, a Hungarian student is embroiled in a national scandal when he fails his exams, accidentally becoming a figurehead for the right.



**Hear My Eyes: Hellraiser**

**FEATURE** Experience Clive Barker's 1987 extra-dimensional horror classic, re-scored live by EBM explorers Hieroglyphic Being and Robin Fox, and synched laser-art show.



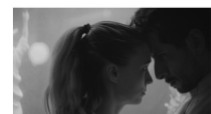
**House Of The Seasons**

**FEATURE** A tofu factory in Daegu, Korea, is the setting for this tender, moving, and funny inter-generational family saga – an award-winning highlight of the Busan International Film Festival.



**In Vitro**

**FEATURE** Ashley Zukerman (Succession) stars in a gripping Australian sci-fi mystery thriller set on a remote cattle farm in the near future.



**La Cocina**

**FEATURE** Rooney Mara and Raúl Briones star in this intense comedic drama set during the hectic lunch rush at a New York restaurant, from Mexican maverick Alonso Ruizpalacios (A Cop Movie, SFF 2021).

**Calendar** contains all dates and times for each film and venue.

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**Program Strands** will show you curated collections of films grouped by genre, style, content and themes.

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Once you have found a film you would like to see (in this case, **Camp de Thiaroye**), **click on the image or title**. This will take you to the film description and ticketing purchase page.



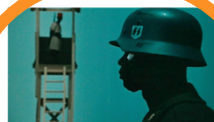
**Black Girl**

**FEATURE** The true story of a young Senegalese girl who moves to France to work as a nanny, but is soon treated as a slave. Sembène's first feature film took him, and African cinema, to international acclaim.



**Borom Sarret**

**SHORT FILM** Borom Sarret (SFF 2015) is Ousmane Sembène's debut film, often hailed as one of the most significant short films ever made – and one that paved the way for African cinema.



**Camp De Thiaroye**

**FEATURE** Winner of the Special Prize at Venice 1989, this uncompromising historical epic tells the story of Senegalese WWII veterans who were betrayed under French colonial rule. Based on true events.



**Ceddo**

**FEATURE** Historical epic *Ceddo* (SFF 1978) remains Ousmane Sembène's most controversial film, strongly indicting both Islam and Christianity and showcasing the traditional African religion that came before them.



**Emitaï**

**FEATURE** Set in Sembène's home territory of Casamance, *Emitaï* is a deceptively simple story of resistance and rebellion chronicling historical oppression by the French in West Africa.

### 2. SELECTING YOUR TICKETS

Once you are on the film description and ticketing page, click the **BOOK TICKETS** button positioned on the right-hand side of the page.

\*Note: *Camp de Thiaroye* will NOT be screening at the State Theatre. The above screenshot is being used solely for this guide.

SFF venues provide allocated seating at most venues. When purchasing tickets to a venue with allocated seating, such as the State Theatre or other CBD locations i.e., Event Cinemas George Street, Dendy Newtown, etc., you have two options on how to select your seats.

\*If you are buying tickets to a film screening at the Hayden Orpheum, Art Gallery of NSW, State Library of New South Wales or Ritz Randwick, neither of these options will be visible as seating at these venues is general admission.

Best Available will automatically select your seats for you based on the seats available to that session. Make sure you select **Keep seats together** if selecting **Best Available** seats.

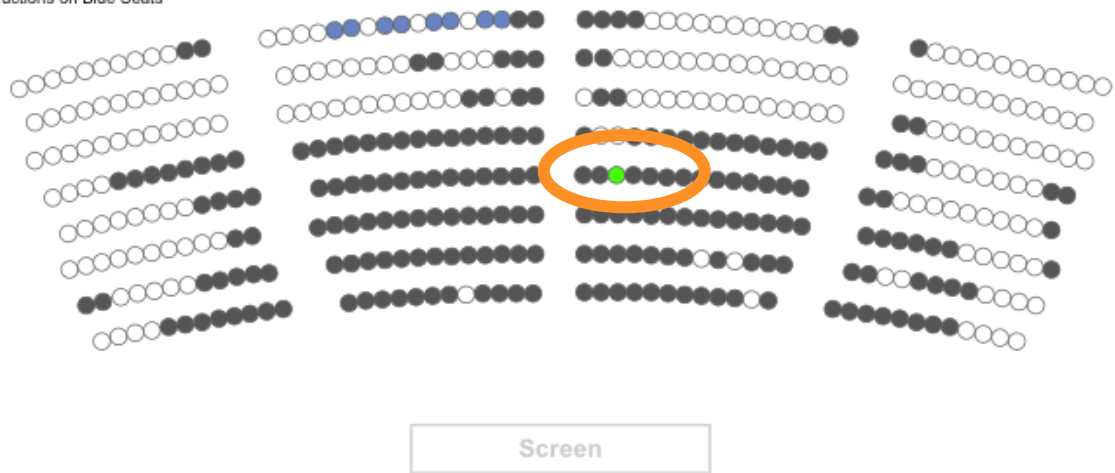

### 3. ENTERING YOUR FLEXIPASS NUMBER

If you are already logged into your account, your Flexipass number will show up automatically. Otherwise enter your Flexipass code in the box labelled **CODE** and click **VALIDATE**.

In the new line that appears, select the quantity of tickets desired (up to 4 tickets per screening on Flexipass 10, 20, 30; up to 2 tickets per screening on Youth and Media passes).

Click **ADD TO CART**. Do not select any quantities from the paid options above the Flexipass line.

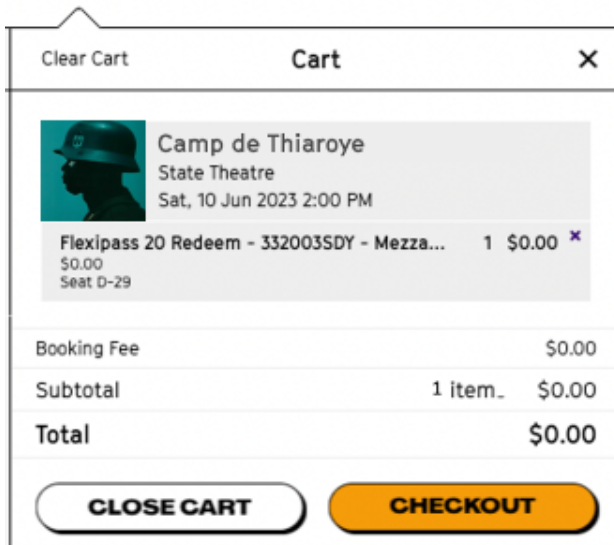

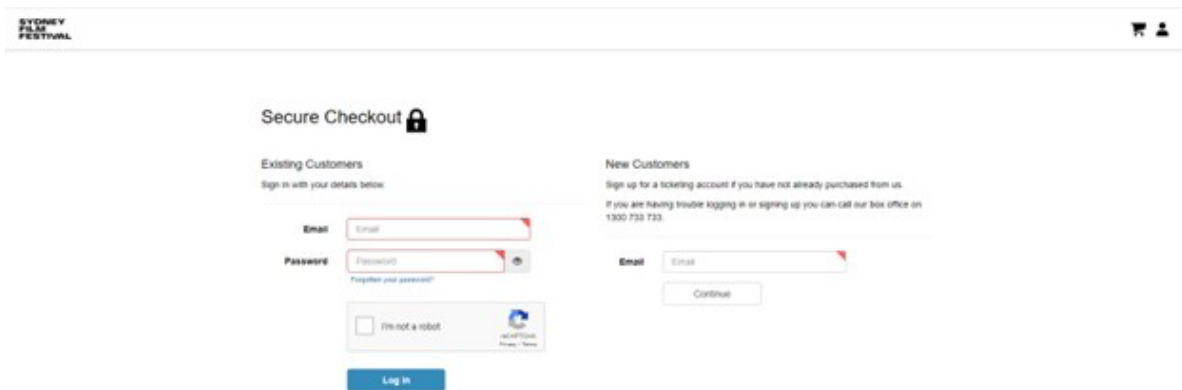
A pop up on the right-hand side will give you a summary of what you have just added. **Make sure to check that the time, venue, and price are correct.**

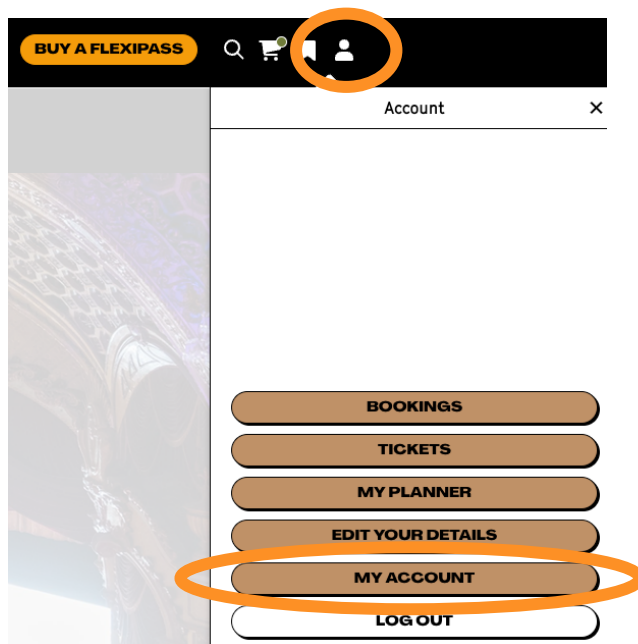
